*Once you were not a people, but now you are the people of God.
(1 Peter 2:10)*

- Who has Calvary become in our 87 year journey?
- What defines us? What distinguishes Calvary from all other organizations, businesses, even churches?

1. A People: not a building, nor an institution, but a _____ of God! (1 Peter 2:4,5; 2:9)

- "As you come to Him, the living Stone" . . . a fortress
- "rejected by men, but chosen by God . . ." His atonement
- "you also . . . are being built into a spiritual house" . . . Church
- "to BE . . . a holy priesthood . . ." intercessors, bridges
- "offering spiritual sacrifices" . . . worship, prayer, battle, service, 'hands and feet of Jesus', mind of Christ
- "a chosen people" . . . Eph. 1:4 Before creation!
- "a royal priesthood" . . . royalty, spiritual leader community
- "a holy nation" . . . Phil. 3:20 "citizenship", 1 Peter 1:13-16
- "a people belonging to God" . . . an ownership people
- "a praise declaring people, called out of darkness"

We are a people defined by our Savior and Lord, Jesus Christ!

2. A _____ people, rescued, ransomed, reconciled People. (Col.1)

- Rescued (redemption) from darkness, condemnation, power of sin. (Col. 1:13,14; Romans 8:1)
- By Jesus Christ fully God (1:15,19; 2:8); Creator (1:16); Sustainer (1:17); Supreme head over all (1:18)
- Restored (reconciled) to innocent relationship (1:20-22)
- Ransomed (atonement), full sin debt paid (1:22; 1 John 4:9)
- Re-born to new life (Col. 2:13-15); Jesus reigns triumphant.

3. A People _____ RESPOND to Jesus Christ our Commander in Chief!

- We are included in His purpose and plan! (Eph. 1:11)
- 1st We BE for God's honor and glory (Eph. 1:12, 3:21)
- 2nd We pursue KNOWING Christ Jesus (Eph. 1:17-21; Phil. 3:8; Jer. 9:23,24)
- 3rd We DO in obedience to our Sovereign King (Col. 3:12-17, 23,24)
- 4th We ENGAGE the world in His name for His fame
 - Eph. 3:10 ". . . His intent was that now through the Church, the manifold wisdom of God should be made known to the rulers and authorities in the heavenly realms . . ."
 - Matt. 28:18-20 ". . . As you are going, make disciples of all nations, baptizing them in the name of the Father, and the Son and the Holy Spirit, and teach them to obey everything I have taught you."
 - Acts 1:8 "the Holy Spirit will come upon you, and you will be My witnesses . . . even to the ends of the world."

4. HOW does Calvary discern and live _____ of Jesus?

- Spiritual Leadership, filled with the Holy Spirit and Wisdom who Discern! (Acts 6:3) God speaks expecting our followership. (Deut. 10:12; OT pattern of God speaking; Acts 5:19; 8:26; 10: 12)
- We worship, we pray, we listen! (Acts 13:2-4)
- We search the Scriptures (1 Tim. 4; 2 Tim. 3; Heb. 4)
- We pursue spiritual maturity and move forward in full submission/obedience to Jesus' Lordship! (Ephesians 4:11-16)
