# Will Your God BE Enough?

2009 Calvary Theme Verses - Part 1

Pastor Doug Anderson January 10-11, 2009

*"The LORD is the everlasting God, the Creator of the ends of the earth. He will not grow tired or weary, and His understanding no one can fathom. Those who hope in the LORD will renew their strength." (Isaiah 40:28,31)*

Isaiah . . . God's prophet during a critical time in Israel's history

- Northern Kingdom falls to Assyrian invasion (722 B.C.)
  - Contrast of leadership (Uzziah, Jotham / Ahaz /Hezekiah / Manasseh) 150 yrs, extremes (2 Chron. 26-33)
  - Is. 40 Messianic hope 700 years future!
- Is. 40:1-5 God initiates His message of Comfort and Hope to His people, during the despair of Manasseh.
- God's discipline is dealt in love, followed by a Redeemer
  - "The glory of the LORD will be revealed to all mankind . . ."
- Is. 40:6-8 God contrasts our glory and His Word
- All human glory is fleeting
  - "The Word of our God stands forever" unchanging truth
- Is. 40: 9-11 Messiah will come in power, but as a Shepherd tending His flock with personal, complete, competent care.  
(John 10) "I know My sheep and My sheep know Me . . ."
- Is. 40:12 God's majesty in all creation is supreme (Rom. 1:20)
- Is. 40:13 God's majesty in spirituality is unsurpassed (1 Cor. 2:10-16)
- Is. 40:14 God's majesty in knowledge and wisdom (Prov. 3:5, 6; 9:10)  
"the fear of the LORD is the beginning of wisdom . . .";  
Prov. 2:6 "for the LORD gives wisdom and from His mouth come knowledge and understanding."

- Is. 40:15-17 God's majesty dwarfs man's achievements (political, military, education, economies, etc)

*What is your measurement for the immenseness of God?  
What are the "fingerprints" of God which most amaze/awe you?  
Why do we consistently tend to minimize, marginalize, discount God?*

- Is. 40:18-24 "to whom will you compare God?"
- Jer. 10 The irony of man making his own gods
  - "do you not know, have you not heard . . ." (Psalm 78 generational privilege/responsibility) (Is. 40:28)
  - "have you not understood since the earth was founded . . ." (Is. 45:18, 19)
  - "He sits enthroned above the earth . . ." God's Sovereign reign over His creation for His glory (Colossians 1:16-18)
  - "its people are like grasshoppers" (Matt. 10:29-31)
- Is. 40:25-26 "To whom will you compare Me . . . ?" (Is. 46)
- Ps. 19:1-6 "the heavens declare the glory of God . . ."
  - "not one of them is missing" (Gen. 15:5)
- Is. 40:27-31 God's invitation that we trust Him
- Why do we assume God doesn't care about each of us?
  - Ps. 94:8-11 "does He who implanted the ear not hear? Does He who formed the eye not see? Does He who teaches man lack knowledge?" Is Psalm 139 true?
  - "The LORD is the everlasting God . . ." eternal/reliable
  - He gives strength . . . He empowers and protects
  - Those who hope in the LORD will find their strength renewed and sufficient for the challenge ahead

*"So do not fear, for I am with you; do not be dismayed for I am your God. I will strengthen you and help you; I will uphold you by My righteous right hand." (Is. 41:10, 13, 20) (Matt. 28:18,20 / John 15)*
