# "His Wounds...our HOPE for Living in 2009"

## ➤ DARK SATURDAY "By His Wounds" Drama

- Remorse . . . The friends of Jesus are overwhelmed by the reality of His death and burial. From the cross He had gasped, "*it is finished*". In this dark hour, everything seems finished. What would the future be without Jesus?
- Remember . . . As they piece together their individual perspectives of what has happened, Jesus' friends strain to remember what He had taught them, how He had tried to prepare them for this dark day.
- Re-consider . . . "By His wounds we are healed". (Is. 53:5) "*they will condemn Him to death . . . He will be flogged and crucified, but on the third day He will rise to life again.*" (Matt. 20:19) What if He stayed dead? What if His promise is true?

## ➤ EASTER SUNRISE CELEBRATION!

- Resolve the confusion . . . nonsense or miracle? (Luke 24:1-12)

*"Why do you look for the living among the dead? He is not here, He is risen! Remember how He told you . . . ?"*

*" . . . they told this to the apostles. But they did not believe the women, because their words seemed like nonsense."*

Is Jesus' resurrection 'nonsense' or the 'cornerstone' of living confidently in 2009? What difference can it make for you?

## ➤ RESURRECTION SUNDAY WORSHIP

- Recognize the result of 'Refuse' . . . (Luke 24:13-20)
  - refuse to consider Jesus' words as truth
  - refuse to acknowledge His miracles as evidence
  - refuse to receive His love freely offered
  - refuse to respond to His invitation
  - 'refuse' leads to rejection!
- Resurrection . . . amazement or absent? (Luke 24:21-29)
  - death destroys hopes of deliverance, rescue
  - time confirms fearful conclusions
  - absent body only creates confusion
  - angels or apparitions?
  - foolish, wise or cautiously skeptical?
  - suffering as the path to glory??

*"All we like sheep have gone astray, each of us has turned to his own way; and the LORD has laid on Him (Jesus) the iniquity of us all. He (Jesus) was pierced for our transgressions, He was crushed for our iniquities; the punishment that brought us peace (with God, with ourselves, with each other) was upon Him, and by His wounds we are healed. (from our sin guilt, and sin wounds)" (Isaiah 53:5,6)*

- Restored hope and relationship! (Luke 24:30-36)
  - Jesus recognized by healed wounds, hosting
  - Hope awakened burns with potential
  - Confident truth joins personal touch for healing
  - Restored relationship builds hope for living

Inner healing and hope . . . can I manufacture it, determine it, or will I receive it from the Risen, Healed Jesus? "His Healed Wounds are my Hope" . . . foolishness or life changing fact?
