**"RAISE THE STANDARD IN PARTNERSHIP"**

*"You will receive power when the Holy Spirit comes on you and you will be My witnesses in Jerusalem, and in and Samaria and to the ends of the earth...and I will be with you always."*

... farewell and commissioning words of Jesus (Acts 1:8; Matt. 28:20)

- **Calvary's Mandate:** *"Help people ENGAGE with God"* (Matt. 28:18-20)  
How many more through partnerships?
- **Calvary's Experience:** *"God REFRESHes those who engage with Him."* (Matt. 11:28) How diverse through partnerships?
- **Calvary's Dynamic:** *"Building spiritual growth relationships with each other, we FOLLOW Jesus Christ in Community.* (Mark 1:16-39) How far can partnerships spread the dynamic?
- **Calvary's Impact:** *"God's refreshed people raise the standard of living as we influence our world."* (Ezekiel 36:23; Ephesians)  
How much more difference can we make in our generation if we multiply our influence through partnerships?
- **God's driving passions. . . the reason for Calvary**
  - 2 Peter 3:9 *"God is not willing that any should perish but everyone come to repentance."* Every person rescued and brought into the family! (Col. 1:13,14)
  - 2 Cor. 5:17 *"If anyone is in Christ he is a new creation, the old has gone, the new has come."* Every person truly transformed by the power of God. (Rom. 8:1)
  - John 15:5 *"I am the vine, you are the branches, if a man remains in Me he will bear much fruit, apart from Me you can do nothing."* Each person living in authentic "followership" relationship with Jesus. (John 8:12; 1 John 2:6)

- *"The Counselor, the Holy Spirit, will teach you all things...will be in you...will guide you into all truth."* (John 14:16,17,26; 16:13)  
Guided by the same Holy Spirit which led and empowered Jesus, God's people can live strategically as God impacts our world through us! Just like Jesus!

➤ **Holy Spirit empowered "raise the standard living" spreads**

- Acts 1-6 Jerusalem transformed by the influence of Spirit empowered Calvary type people!
  - Pentecost...3000 drawn to Jesus! (Acts 2)
  - Disabled man healed, soon 5000 had trusted in Jesus! (Acts 4:12 *"There is no other name by which men can be saved"*)
  - Generosity enabled church cared for needs, including widows, and Apostle provision. (Acts 2:42-47; 4:34-37; 6) *"the number of disciples increased rapidly in Jerusalem."*
- Acts 7-11 Judea and Samaria impacted by Jesus transformed people "scattered" by the Holy Spirit.
  - Stephen's persecution "scatters" Christians
  - Philip impacts Samaria (Acts 8)
  - Saul's Damascus road conversion (Acts 9)
  - *"the church throughout Judea, Galilee and Samaria...was strengthened by the Holy Spirit and grew..."* (Acts 9:31)
  - Peter reaches to Cornelius . . .Gentiles are welcomed into God's global family! (Acts 10)
  - Antioch impacted by "Christians" (Acts 11)  
*"they were called Christians first in Antioch"*
