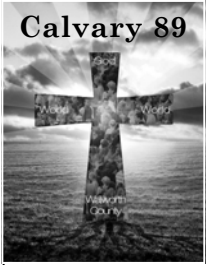

"Raise the Standard...Live in AWE of God"

"I have heard of Your fame, I stand in awe of Your deeds, O LORD. Renew them in our day, in our time make them known." (Hab. 3:2)

"I consider everything a loss compared to the surpassing greatness of knowing Christ Jesus my Lord. I want to know Christ and the power of His resurrection." (Phil. 3:8,10)

➤ **Raise the Standard Living in Awe of God is a _____**

- Eph. 1:3 Praise is due God, will I choose to praise Him?
- Eph. 1:3 God has provided 'every spiritual' blessing, will I choose to accept His great gifts or demand my blessing list?
- Reconciliation - Regeneration - Eternal Life - Holy Spirit presence
- Eph. 1:4 He chose us, before the creation of the world! How do I respond to His choice to create, love and draw me?
- Eph. 1:4 God designed me to BE holy and blameless, a work only He could do in me...is it my daily choice too? How?
- Eph. 1:5 He chose to provide redemption and adoption... through Jesus Christ, will I choose this new life, daily? How?
- Eph. 1:6 God chose to offer His grace to us freely through Jesus Christ, do I accept it or demand some other way?
- Eph. 1:5 "in accordance with His pleasure and will" Is His delight my ambition, my satisfaction? How much would my life change if I chose daily to live in AWE of God's reach to me?

How would living this AWE *raise the standard* all around me through my influence?

➤ **Raise the Standard Living in Awe of God is an _____**

- Eph. 1:7 *In Christ we have 'redemption'* (rescue from sin bondage and condemnation). Forgiveness (and cleansing) from rebellion...all according to wealth of God's grace work! Do I LIVE rescued, freed, forgiven, cleansed...or still bound?
- Eph. 1:8,9 "He made known to us the mystery of His will..." God's grace lavished on us with wisdom and understanding... our experience is expanded in wise understanding! How do I live evidencing my understanding of the mystery?
- Eph. 1:10 God's mystery is accomplished in Christ...in the fullness of time! (Hab. 3:2) What is unique about "our time" 2009? What will 2010-2020 bring? Who will I become?

- Eph. 1:11,12 "In Him we were chosen...according to the plan of Him who works out everything in conformity with the purpose of His will...in order that we might BE for the praise of His glory." What is His great plan for me... to BE for His praise?
- Eph. 1:13,14 "having believed you were marked with a seal, the promised Holy Spirit..." How does my daily life reflect His seal of identification? Is my life honorable to Jesus?
- How is Jesus using my life to "raising the standard" of my world? Is it evident to ALL that I live in AWE of Him?
