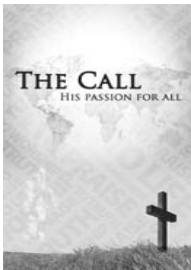
### Bereavement

## "The Call...His Passion for All..." RESURRECTION

*"If Christ has not been raised, your faith is futile and you are still in your sin." (1 Corinthians 15:17)*

### ➤ God's Passion seen in His extreme initiative

- John 3:16 *"For God SO loved the world, that He gave..."*
- Rom. 5:8 *"God demonstrates His own love for us in this..."*
- 1 John 4:9,10 *"This is how God showed His love among us..."*
- John 15:13 *"Greater love has no one than this..."*

What is your assessment of God's extreme love for you? How do you honor God's unconditional love initiative toward you?

### ➤ God's Passion devised a remarkable Redemption Plan

- Incarnation...God coming to live among us
- Relationship...God fully engaging with humanity personally
- Atonement...God paying the full death price for our sin
- Resurrection...God defeating death, sin, Satan to reign again
- Ascension...God returning to be our Advocate and Sovereign

Can you grasp the magnitude of God's remarkable redemption plan? How do you evaluate your personal response thus far in your life time?

### ➤ Resurrection...the cornerstone of Christianity

- Acts 2:24,32 *"God raised Jesus to life, we are witnesses..."*
- Acts 3:15 *"You killed the author of life, God raised Him from the dead."*
- Acts 4:10,12 *"It is by the name of Jesus Christ...whom you crucified but whom God raised from the dead, that this man stands before you healed....There is no other name under heaven given to men by which we must be saved."*

Nothing was more important in those first months than the clear proclamation that Jesus Christ crucified, is raised from the dead!

### ➤ What does the resurrection accomplish?

- IDENTITY *"...who was declared with power to be the Son of God by His resurrection from the dead: Jesus Christ" (Rom. 1:4)*
- FORGIVEN / PURE *"He was delivered over to death for our sins and was raised to life for our justification." (Rom. 4:25)*
- ADVOCATE *"Christ Jesus who was raised to life is at the right hand of God and is also interceding for us." (Rom. 8:34)*
- SALVATION *"If you confess with your mouth Jesus is Lord, and believe...that God raised Him from the dead, you will be saved. (Rom. 10:9,10)*

So...who is the resurrected Jesus Christ for you?

### ➤ Resurrection...So what?

- 1 Cor. 15:14,15, 17-20 *"If Christ has not been raised...our preaching is useless, we are false witnesses about God, your faith is futile, you are still in your sin, those who have fallen asleep in Christ are lost...we are to be pitied more than all men."*
- 1 Corinthians 15:3-8 *"Christ died for our sins...He was raised on the third day...He appeared to the twelve...and to me."*

- Resurrection New Life...

2 Cor. 5:17 *"Therefore if anyone is in Christ he is a new creation..."*

- Resurrection Peace...

Rom. 5:1 *"Since we have been justified, we have peace with God through our Lord Jesus Christ..."*

John 16:33 *"...in Me you will have peace. In this world you will have trouble, but take heart, I have overcome the world."*

- Resurrection Power...

Phil. 3:7 *"I want to know Christ and the power of His resurrection."*

1 John 4:4 *"greater is He that is in you than He that is in the world."*
