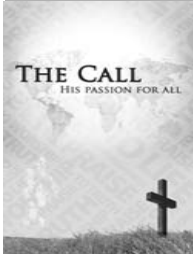
### Bereavement

**“The Call...His Passion for All... Expectations”**

*God’s extreme love Initiative is an Invitation with Expectations*

*God’s Response Pattern: Belief; Trust; Turn; Receive; Impact Living*

*“These things are written that you may believe that Jesus is the Christ, the Son of God, and that by believing you may have life in His name.” (John 20:31)*

**God’s Redemption Strategic Plan**

- **Incarnation:** (Joseph & Mary) (Luke 1,2; Matt. 1,2)
  - *Believe* the angelic announcements / explanation
  - *Trust* God to accomplish the unimaginable
  - *Turn* from fear, self-focus to God’s Purposes
  - *Receive* God’s courageous peace, unexplainable pregnancy, man’s opposition, Holy Spirit guidance.
  - *Live* the Adventure...parents to Jesus!
  
- **Relationship:** (Disciples)
  - *Believe* Jesus is who He claimed to be (John 1)
  - *Trust* Him enough to “follow Me” (Mark 1)
  - *Turn* from self-reliance, release life plans to God’s Plans
  - *Receive* the Holy Spirit in power (Acts 1)
  - *Live* as an Apostle...and later a martyr (Acts)
  
- **Atonement Death:** (Christians) (Romans 5, 6, 8)
  - *Believe* God incarnate, Jesus, died on the cross
  - *Trust* His death is purposeful, can accomplish redemption
  - *Turn* from sin, self-trust to Jesus for Salvation
  - *Receive* God’s full forgiveness, adoption, reconciliation
  - *Live* a God honoring life free from sin’s domination

- **Victorious Resurrection:** (1 Peter 2:9,10; Ephes. 2:1-10)
  - *Believe* Jesus’ bodily, healed resurrection is truth
  - *Trust* God’s resurrection power defeats Sin, Death, Satan
  - *Turn* from doubt/death to life/sanctification (Col. 1)
  - *Receive* resurrection deliverance and empowerment
  - *Live* in resurrection relationship with the Living Christ knowing Him and His power personally (Phil. 3)
  
- **Ascension:** (Acts 1; 2 Corinthians 5:14-20)
  - *Believe* the eye witness accounts and angelic explanation
  - *Trust* Jesus is now at God’s right hand interceding, soon to return in Rapture power! (Heb. 1,10; 1 Thess. 4)
  - *Turn* to your Sovereign often for wisdom, guidance, help
  - *Receive* the privilege/responsibility of an ambassador
  - *Live* ‘The Call’ in anticipation of Christ’s soon return and eternal reign. (1 Thess. 4:13-18; Rev. 20,21)
  
- **God’s Expectations of those living this New Life in Christ:**
  - Open and frequent communication (prayer: a dialogue with God, yields answers, guidance, builds relationship) (Phil. 4)
  - A worshiping heart and mind (Col. 3) free from darkness
  - Integrity of Christ-like character (1 John 1,2)
  - Compassionate love reach of Jesus to world (John 13)
  - Courage of Holy Spirit indwelling/presence in a troubled world (John 16,17)
  - Empowered warriors pushing back the darkness. (Ephesians 5,6)
  - God honoring, life-long marriages developing the next generation of great families (Eph. 5,6; Col. 3)
  - Inter-generational partnerships, mutually beneficial (Titus 2)
  - Spiritually mature to personal holiness (Eph.4; 1 Peter 1:15)
  - Building and leaving God honoring legacies (1 Tim. 3,4)
  - Build the Christ Lordship global church which penetrates the darkness (Ephesians 3, Colossians 1, 1 Peter 1,2)
