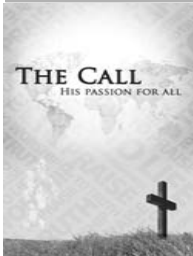

“Friends, haven’t you caught anything...come have breakfast... do you love Me...follow Me” (John 21)

➤ **“The Call”...His total understanding of me! (John 21:1-14)**

- *“Before I formed you in the womb I knew you...” (Jer. 1:5)*
- *“Before a word is on my tongue you know it completely O LORD.” (Psalm 139:4)*
- *“You are the God who sees me...Jehovah Lahai Roi” (Gen. 16:13)*
