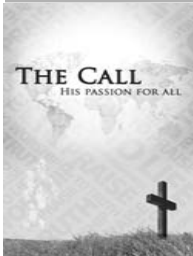

**“The Call...His Passion for All... Commissioned Community”**

**“Follow Me...the Holy Spirit will come upon you...His intent is that through the church the manifold wisdom of God is made known...” (Acts 1:8; Eph. 3:10)**

➤ **“The Call”... Moving from you to YOU to a global, multi-generational, Holy Spirit led Community of Jesus followers**

- John 21:22 *“If I want him...you must follow Me.”*

What is the dynamic of the relationship Jesus purchased and desires with me?  
 What distorts or restrains / nourishes or motivates it?

- Matt. 28:18-20 *“All authority...is given to Me. As you are going, make disciples of all peoples...I will be with you.”*

How does Jesus exercise His Sovereign authority in my world? How am I making disciples? Followership: who am I learning from / who am I teaching? How do I sense Him near? How does my ‘followership life’ fit in the larger Jesus movement of Walworth County?

- Acts 1:6-8 *“they met together...Jesus said, ‘you will receive power when the Holy Spirit comes upon you, and you will BE My ambassadors.’”*

Who is the Holy Spirit to me? How is He alive in my life? (guide, convict, teach)  
 How is Holy Spirit POWER active in my life? How are WE (me and my fellow ambassadors) impacting our world by Him?

- Acts 1:9 *“He was taken up before their eyes...”*

Am I confident this is historical fact? Where did Jesus go and what is He doing now? (Rom. 8:34; Heb. 1:3; 4:14-16; 9:15; 10:19-25)

- Acts 1:14 *“They joined together...in prayer...”*

Why? What is my understanding of my prayer privilege, God’s desire for conversation with us, the power of prayer connection with Jesus? What holds me back...how much have we missed? (2 Chron. 7:14; Phil. 4:6,7,12,13; John 14:13; 15:7; 16:23,24) (‘Lord teach us to pray’)

- Acts 2:1-12 *“...the day of Pentecost, they were all together in one place... tongues of fire came to rest on each of them...they were all filled with the Holy Spirit.”*

Why were they together? Am I poised for God to use me/us strategically in His global purpose? Am I ‘filled with the Holy Spirit’? (Acts 2:4; 4:8,32; 6:3,5; 7:55)  
 What evidence do we have that Calvary is a people “filled with the Holy Spirit”, engaged fully with God’s local and global strategic purposes under the Lordship of Jesus Christ?

- Acts 2:42-47 *“The believers were together...shared what they had... continued to meet together...and the Lord added daily those who were being saved.”*

The call of God invites individual repentance response which yields a community of Jesus redeemed people living transformed, empowered lives which are contagious and reproduce the next generation of Christ followers! Is this Calvary? Am I an active part of this?
