"God's Mysteries Revealed"

"There is a God in heaven who reveals mysteries."
(Daniel 2:28)

➤ Daniel's mysterious relationship with God

- captive yet positioned as a spokesman for God (Daniel 1:3,21)
- defiled yet empowered by God for God's glory (1:7,17)
- an impossible demand, a mystery revealed (2:18,19)
- a God who reveals mysteries (2:28,29)...is the God of gods (2:47)

As I begin my summer 2010, what's my 'situation'?

➤ The Mystery of God

- How can we know? (Rom. 1:18-20 / Ps. 14:1)
 - "The heavens declare the glory of God" (Ps. 19:1-4)
 - Observable logic...it's all too complex
 - Innate sense of moral right and wrong
 - Every people ever discovered worship "god"
 - Encounters...Scripture...Jesus Christ
 - Forgiven, transformed, empowered people!
 - God...Unique "apart from Me there is no God" (Is. 45:5;46:9; Acts 17:24-31) Is the Jewish God, Muslim God and Christian God all the same God??
- "Hear O Israel, the LORD our God, the LORD is one." (Deut. 6:4)
 "There is no other God worthy of worship except Allah and Muhammad is His messenger" (Shahadah)
 "You are the Christ, the Son of the living God." (Matt. 16:16)
- God...Eternally existing, self-sustaining!
 - Gen. 1:1; John 1:1; "In the beginning God..."
 - Is. 43:10 "Before Me no god was formed..."
 - Is. 40:28 "The LORD is the everlasting God"

• God...Originator of all things

- Is. 40:26 "lift up your eyes, look to the heavens, Who created all these...?"
 - Is. 45:18 "He who created the heavens, He is God; He fashioned and made the earth...and He says I am the LORD, and there is no other."
 - Col. 1:15-17 "...by Him all things were created...He is before all things and in Him all things hold together." (Jesus Christ)

- God...Holy, Just, Redeeming a rebellious humanity
 - Lev. 11:44,45; 19:2; 20:7 "I am the LORD your God, be holy because I am holy." (Is. 6:3)
 - Ps. 9:8 "The LORD will judge the world in righteousness; He will govern...with justice."
 - 1 Peter 1:18,19 "you were not redeemed with perishable things...but with the precious blood of Christ."
 - God...a Triune God...Father, Son, Holy Spirit, achieving our redemption, providing our irreversible salvation
 - Jesus..."The Word became flesh and made His dwelling among us..."(John 1:1-14); "I give them eternal life...I and the Father are one"(John 10:28,30); "He was raised to life for our justification"(Rom. 4:25); "He is able to save completely, those who come to God through Him."(Heb. 7:25)
 - Holy Spirit..."The Spirit gives birth to spirit"(John 3:6); "The Holy Spirit will teach you all things"(14:26) "you are controlled not by the sinful nature but by the Spirit of God living in you."(Rom. 8:9)
- "He made known to us the mystery of His will which He purposed in Christ."(Eph. 1:9)
