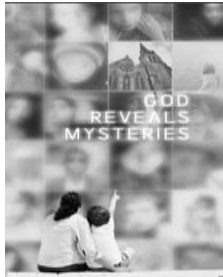

"God Reveals Mysteries. . .The Future"

"Listen, I tell you a mystery, we will not all sleep, but we will all be changed...at the last trumpet..." (1 Cor. 15:51)

➤ The Rapture of the Church and Resurrection of the Saints

- "This same Jesus, who has been taken from you into heaven, will come back in the same way you have seen Him go." (Acts 1:11) He's coming back!
- "God will bring with Jesus those who have fallen asleep in Him. For the Lord Himself will come down from heaven...and the dead in Christ will rise first. After that we who are still alive will be caught up together with them in the clouds to meet the Lord in the air." (1 Thess. 4:13-18) The visible, rapture of Christians, both living and dead, together with Jesus Christ forever!
- "Flesh and blood cannot inherit the kingdom of God...we will not all sleep, but we will all be changed...for the trumpet will sound, the dead will be raised imperishable..." (1 Cor. 15:50-53) All believers in Jesus will receive heavenly, immortal bodies.
- "They came to life and reigned with Christ...the rest of the dead did not come to life till after the thousand years...Blessed and holy are those who have part in the first resurrection." (Rev. 20:4-6) Only believers in Jesus Christ are raised and given new bodies at this time, the 'first resurrection'.

➤ The Millennial Kingdom of Jesus Christ (Rev. 20:1-7)

- "He seized...Satan, and bound him for a thousand years...to keep him from deceiving the nations..." (Rev. 20:2,3) Satan's deceptive authority limited by Jesus during the millennium.
- "And there was given Him (Jesus Christ) dominion and glory and a kingdom, that all people, nations and languages should serve Him." (Dan. 7:13-14) A kingdom foretold in OT times!
- Amillennialism... a spiritual kingdom in heart and mind.

- Premillennialism... Christ raptures the Church before the literal, on earth, millennial kingdom reign of Christ.
- Postmillennialism... the Gospel improves mankind till Christ's return.

➤ The Great Tribulation / Antichrist / Day of the LORD

- "The man of lawlessness...will oppose and will exalt himself over everything that is called God or worshiped, so that he sets himself up in God's temple, proclaiming himself to be God." (2 Thess. 2:3,4) The Antichrist will be a Satan empowered man deceitfully peaceful, but totally opposed to God.
- "For there will be great distress (great tribulation) unequalled from the beginning of time...if those days had not been cut short, no one would survive." The period of terrible turmoil on earth beginning with the 'Abomination of Desolation' (Dan. 9:27) and concluding with the 'Day of the LORD' (1 Thess. 5:1-11; Rev. 6:17) outpouring of God's wrath on the earth.
- "These are those who have come out of the great tribulation..." (Rev. 7:14) The Church will be raptured to God's presence!
 - "pre-tribulational rapture" before Daniel's 70th week
 - "mid-trib rapture" immediately prior to the Great Tribulation, midway through the 7 years of trouble
 - "pre-wrath rapture" immediately prior to the "Day of the LORD" and God's outpouring of final wrath.
 - "post-trib rapture" at the conclusion of the entire 7 years of trouble, Christ returns to His millennial reign.
- Seals 1-4 (Rev. 6:1-8) Death and devastation due to man's inhumanity to man. (Matt. 24:4-8)
- 5th Seal... 'Abomination of Desolation', great martyrdom of saints (Rev. 6:9-11; Matt. 24:9-13)
- 6th Seal... God caused Cosmic Disturbances (Rev. 6:12-16)
- 7th Seal... 7 Trumpet judgments of God upon the rebellious world (Jew and Gentile) that has rejected Him (Rev. 8,9)
- 7 Bowl judgments of God's wrath upon the nations for their mistreatment of Israel (Rev. 16)
- Battle of Armageddon, Christ's return for His Millennial Kingdom reign. (Rev. 19, 20)
- Second Resurrection (the unsaved); Great White Throne judgment; lake of fire for Satan and unsaved. (Rev. 20:11-15)
- New heaven and new earth for eternity (Rev. 21)

"Behold I am coming soon" (Rev. 22:7, 12, 20) How do I live today for God's glory in anticipation of this future?
